## North Access Road Grand Opening

October 22, 2009



The DeLand Airport celebrated the grand opening of the new North Access Road on October 22, 2009. This project has been over five years in the making, and the City is proud to open up the north side of the airport. In recent years the airport has been running low on available land to lease. In 2009 the airport was approximately 95% leased for all improved land. The new North Access Road has now opened up 95+/- acres of improved land ready to build with an approved St. Johns River Water Management permit. This land is not only pre-permitted for easy development but can accommodate very large scale buildings with and without aviation access.

Phase I & II are now complete, and Phase III is designed and ready for construction when the time is right. If you would like to obtain more information please contact the Airport Manager, Nickolis Landgraff, or Bob Turk, Economic Development Manager for the City of DeLand.

## Runway 12 Safety Area & Taxiway 'G' Upgrades

In a joint participation agreement with the FDOT, FAA and the DeLand Airport we have been able to upgrade our airport in two distinct ways, most of which is still currently under construction. The Runway 12 Safety Area will enclose the ditch line that lies within the runway protection zone (RPZ) and grade the area so that in the event of an emergency an aircraft will be able to land safely. The airport has previously had an aircraft crash into this ditch line.

Taxiway 'G' which accesses the Northeast Hangar Complex from runway 30 is being reopened. This will help the movement of aircraft between runway 30 and 23 as well as the Northeast Hangar Complex. Construction for each should be completed by summer 2010.



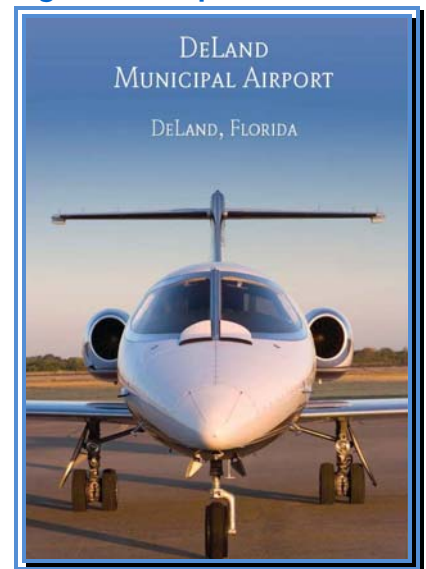
## Security Upgrades & Fencing

The airport has entered into a joint participation agreement with the FDOT to upgrade our security fence lines in coordination with the new North Access Road as well as installing a new surveillance system. The new surveillance system will monitor all of the vehicular access points along with the airport apron, FBO, and fueling facilities. This will be recorded 24/7 and signs will be posted around the airport to improve airport security. This new system is so advanced it will be recording everything in high definition allowing perfect clarity day or night. The two projects are expected to be completed by summer 2010.



## Airport Development Projects Update

- ➔ **North Perimeter Access Road** – Grand opening was October 22, 2009.
- ➔ **Air Traffic Control Tower** – Location determined during safety risk management panel. Expected completion and in operation fall, 2012.
- ➔ **Taxiway 'D'** – Awaiting FAA funding.
- ➔ **Runway 12 Safety Area** – Under construction, expected completion June, 2010.
- ➔ **Taxiway 'G'** – Under construction, expected completion March, 2010.
- ➔ **Additional Security Fencing** – expected award in March 2010 for completion by July, 2010
- ➔ **Install Security Surveillance System** – expected award in March 2010 for completion by June, 2010.
